<u>Circuit Breaker</u>

Missouri State lawmakers created a way to reduce property taxes called a "circuit breaker" because it protects taxpayers from a property tax "overload" just like an electric circuit breaker: when a property tax bill exceeds a certain percentage of a taxpayer's income, the circuit breaker reduces property taxes in excess of this "overload" level. Missouri Qualifications:

- Single with a total income of less than \$27,500
- Married with a total income of less than \$29,500
- Owned or rented a home the entire year of 2019.
- Property taxes were paid by yourself or your landlord.
- You were 65 years of age as of 12/31/2018
- <u>OR</u> You receive SSI or Social Security Disability insurance.

Then you are qualified to apply with a form MO-1040P

and it can be filled out online and printed to mail in with required documentation.
