Remember OATS is affordable and can be used for the following:

- Medical

Long Distance Medical Transportation is available from Camden County to Jefferson City and Columbia runs every Wednesday.

Fares are \$10.00 for a round trip, \$6.00 for one-way. Reservations must be made at least 3 days in advance; appointments should be made 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. Pick up points have been established along the routes; however, the bus will go of route up to 3 miles. The route will begin at Orscheln's at 1089 US 54 in Camdenton.

Second Stop/Pick up point is Osage Beach Outlets—Main Entrance—Pick up in First Bank Parking Lot, Osage Beach.

To schedule a ride, call 1-800-269-6287. Monday-Friday 9AM to 3PM and ask for the weekly Express.
