Housing Voucher Program

For 25 families, CCDDR helps to pay a portion of their rent each month. There are others on the waiting list for the program.

For all clients who are currently receiving a housing voucher and for those who are on the waiting list, there is a *mandatory* class. Families who choose not to attend one of the four sessions offered are removed from the program. The classes will be held at 255 Keystone Industrial park Drive, Camdenton, MO 65020 and will last about one hour. If anyone needs transportation to the training, that can be arranged. People on the program or on the waiting list are encouraged to RSVP by Friday February 15, 2019. The four options for the class are as follows:

- Monday March 4, 2019 at 6:00 pm
- Tuesday March 5, 2019 at 4:00 pm
- Wednesday March 6, 2019 at 10:00 am or at 4:00 pm on the same day.

There are significant changes to the program coming up in the weeks ahead. The classes will give you an opportunity to ask

questions if there is anything that you are confused about.
