Reverse Job Fair

At a typical job fair, employers are lined up around the building showing off their company and entice people to apply to work for them. Reverse job fair turns the tables on that process. Potential employees, create a portfolio on a trifold board, create business cards, and edit resumes during a workshop to be held February 8, 2019 from 10 to noon at 255 Keystone Industrial Park Drive, Camdenton. Both the trifold board and your resumes will give be designed to help get the attention of employers on the date of the fair. Mock interviews will be conducted to help you practice that skill so you will be ready to shine to potential employers on the date of the fair.

The March 1, 2019 Job Fair will open with speakers who have taken the plunge before you to share their success stories. This event will be held at State Fair Community College on Friday March 1, 2019. The address is 3797 Osage Beach Parkway, Osage Beach, MO. This is designed so the employers come to **you** and interview people who will be a good fit for their agency. There is the possibility that you could be interviewed by multiple employers in the same day. This would improve your chances of getting the job that best fits your interests and skills.

By law, employers cannot ask if a person has a disability. But they can ask if a person needs accommodations. Some employers have failed to hire persons with disabilities because they assumed the cost of accommodations would be too high. The reverse job fair gives them a chance to realize they can hire a valuable, loyal employee with minimal accommodation costs.

So please contact your Support Coordinator and let them know that you want to sign up now. We must have RSVPs so that we have enough supplies on hand for the workshop where you will create your trifold board and resume. We are putting together a team of people that will help you get prepared and be ready to showcase your skills so that you can find a job in March of 2019.
