Access Day at the Missouri State Fair

Access Day gives individuals with disabilities from across the state an opportunity to enjoy a special day at the Missouri State Fair, hosted by the Missouri Jaycees. It is held on the last Friday of the State Fair each year. It starts early—around 9:00 AM—and ends around 3:00 PM.

The Missouri Jaycees started hosting Access Day in the 1970's when the Governor's wife asked them to host an event at the Missouri State Fair that would benefit disabled individuals throughout the state. The Jaycees feel this gives them an opportunity to give back to the community at large and help out those who otherwise might not be able to attend the Fair. Individuals with disabilities and their caregivers are given free admission to the State Fair, free parking, and a free carnival game ticket. Every guest receives a hot lunch and lots of fun-filled entertainment. Guests are also given the opportunity to purchase discounted carnival ride wristbands if they desire.
