Monthly Reports

Arc of the Lake Myrna Blaine

Not a lot of changes have been made since last meeting. The ARC of the Lake has 2 new board members. The Arc is still drafting their strategic plan and is and working on getting the inclusive playground. The Arc's next board meeting is the first Tuesday in October at 6pm at the Miller County Senate Bill 40 office.

Lake Ozarks Developmental Center (LODC) Marilyn Martin

LODC is working with DMH and Rolla Regional to amend their contract. LODC is a member of MARF and receiving a lot of useful information. Assessments are being gathered to find out how many people would like community employment. LODC and People's First Halloween party will be October 20. The annual LODC audit conducted by Evers and Company will be the week of September 26th. AED equipment will be purchased by LODC with a \$1300 grant that was received. The equipment is compatible with the Camdenton Ambulance District. A LODC staff member is training to be CPR instructor.

Children's Learning Center (CLC) Susan Daniels

CLC's attendance is now 23 children. September 24th will be the annual yard sale and October 28th CLC will be sponsoring their annual trunk or treat. Anyone interested in participating in the trunk or treat needs to contact Susan at CLC. The two Sunday December Celebration cruises have been sold out and Celebration Cruises of Osage Beach is opening up a third Sunday. CLC will receive half of the monies taken in for the cruises. The new playground is complete except for one area.

Lake Area Industries (LAI) Tiffany Maasen

Contract Packaging is picking up. The foam project is doing well but waiting on inspection. Gifted Gardens will open on September for 5 to 6 weeks selling mums and other fall items. Clothing is not being picked up and clothes are being given to thrift stores in Springfield (Victory Mission). Gift Cards are being given to LAI employees to be used at Gifted Goods and Garments. Gifted Goods and Garments is maintaining but not breaking even. LAI has 44 DD employees and have no waiting list for employment. A meeting with CCDDR will be held Thursday. Wood products price is increasing. Transportation is doing well: some LAI drivers will retire at end of year or find employment with OATS. There is concern with parents of LAI employees who will be using public transportation/OATS. The concern lies with "who" may be on the bus. LAI stated parents would like to meet with OATS to discuss some of their concerns regarding situations that might arise.

Old Business for Discussion

• Transportation Updates

Some families are concerned about transportation; employment is the driving force behind all of this. Surveys have been sent out and returned to access the need for transportation. A deviated route system will be used. OATS will meet to talk with families. OATS funding for the aging is has diminished over the years. DMH is excited about what CCDDR is trying to accomplish regarding transportation needs as it will free up state monies. A presentation on transportation will be held September 21 at the Linn Creek Employment center. Jack Heusted with OATS will attend a CCDDR board meeting before year's end to also do a presentation regarding OATS/CCDDR transportation.

• Macks Creek Park Community Event

CCDDR and the Macks Creek Park Advisory Board will sponsor a picnic on Saturday, September 24 at the Macks Creek Park. Camden County Commissioners approved negotiations with Unlimited Play to develop an inclusive playground for the park. CCDDR will be involved with the playground startup.

• Victimization Public Awareness Campaign

A filming of the first Victimization Public Awareness Campaign for Camden County has been completed. The film will premier at the ARC of Missouri's Third Annual Education Summit on October 12th at Stoney Creek Conference Center in Columbia. CCDDR board members are invited to attend.

The Rolla Satellite Regional Office (RSRO) conducts ISP reviews each quarter on 5 to 8 persons on CCDDR caseloads. The second quarter, all 5 plans chosen by the RSRO met 100% compliance. Once a year the RSRO picks 1 client from each Support Coordinator's caseload and reviews the personal work and the paperwork completed by the Support Coordinator. This is the first year CCDDR did not get an APSE.

Kudos to Myrna and TCM folks for the great reviews received from RSRO. Every 3 years, the Missouri State Highway patrol performs an audit regarding background requests from CCDDR. The results from the audit showed CCDDR being 100% compliant. TCM income is a little lower than usual but only \$1,085 off budget. Paperwork for Medicaid eligibility determination and spend down needs to be received in a timelier manner. Presently we are at 85% Medicaid eligibility. There is not much flexibility in the budget.

Discussion and Conclusion of Resolutions:

1. Resolution 2016-37 – Authorization for Executive Director to Effect a Change in Health Insurance Provider and coverage.

Employee's health insurance is paid 100% by agency. In the past, a couple of potential employees turned down employment due to insurance for spouse/family not being paid by CCDDR. MACDDS is working with MPR to get a group rate savings on health insurance. Quotes are being received from other insurance carriers as well to see if CCDDR can offer cheaper family/spouse/dependent rates. Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, our current carrier, requested a letter of termination by October 1st if agency decides to obtain a different insurance carrier for 2017. If rates and coverages are better, comparable, cheaper or close to current insurance, this resolution would allow Executive Director to execute a letter to terminate plan with Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan for year 2017 upon review and approval from the Board Chairman.





<u>Total Income</u>: During September of 2016 and overall year-to-date, TCM Program total income is slightly higher than budgeted expectations. CCDDR continues to monitor several individuals/guardians/families who have not yet submitted all information to re-certify annual Medicaid eligibility, causing a lapse in Medicaid coverage, and several individuals/guardians/families who have not been submitting Medicaid spend-down invoices to CCDDR for payment, causing a lapse in Medicaid coverage. CCDDR is working with families/individuals/guardians to submit spend-down invoices to CCDDR immediately upon receipt and assist with Medicaid re-certification completion/submission.

<u>Total Expenses:</u> During September of 2016, overall TCM Program expenses were less than anticipated in almost all categories. Overall YTD TCM expenses are lower than budgeted in all categories. Mechanisms are in place to reduce expenses if total income does not meet budgeted expectations.


