STABLE Accounts allow individuals with disabilities to save and invest money <u>without losing eligibility for certain public benefits programs, like Medicaid or SSI.</u> Earnings in your STABLE Account are not subject to federal income tax, so long as you spend them on “Qualified Disability Expenses.”
